3-9-9: PENALTY:

Any person violating any provisions of this chapter shall be fined as provided in section 1-4-1 of this code for each offense, and a separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day during or on which a violation occurs or continues. (1966 Code § 268; amd. 2013 Code)

Chapter 10 SOUND AMPLIFIERS

3-10-1: LICENSE REQUIRED:

It shall be unlawful to maintain or operate any loudspeaker or amplifier connected with any radio, phonograph, microphone or other device by which sounds are magnified and made heard over any public street or public place without having first secured a license therefor. (1966 Code § 565; amd. 2013 Code)

3-10-2: APPLICATION FOR LICENSE:

Any person desiring a license for the use or operation of such device shall file an application therefor with the village clerk, upon a form provided by him, setting forth the name and address of the applicant, the name of the owner of such device, the date upon which it is intended to be used and such other information as may be prescribed. (1966 Code § 567)

3-10-3: LICENSE FEES:

The fees for licenses to be granted under this chapter shall be as follows:

A. For the use or operation of any radio receiving set, talking machine, amplifier or other similar device to be operated from a fixed location and not in a moving vehicle, one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for any day or part of a day for which the licensee desires to be licensed hereunder.

B. For the use or operation of any radio receiving set, talking machine, amplifier or other similar

device to be used in a moving vehicle along the streets, twenty five dollars (\$25.00) for any day or part of day for which the licensee desires to be licensed hereunder. (1966 Code § 566)

3-10-4: ISSUANCE OF LICENSE:

The license shall be issued upon the payment of the license fee, as above provided, to the village clerk, and shall permit the use of any such device subject to the terms and conditions of this chapter, only upon the date specified on such license and no other. (1966 Code § 568)

3-10-5: USE RESTRICTIONS:

- A. No licensee shall use or operate or employ any such device within the village limits on Sunday, or after the hours of eight o'clock (8:00) P.M., prevailing time, of any day, or before the hour of eight o'clock (8:00) A.M., prevailing time, of any day. (1966 Code § 569)
- B. No licensee shall use, operate or employ any such device within a radius of two (2) blocks from any hospital or within the radius of two (2) blocks from any place of worship while funeral services are being held there. (1966 Code § 569; amd. 2013 Code)
- C. No licensee shall cause or permit to be emanated or emitted from any such device any lewd, obscene, profane or indecent language or sounds or any false representation of any matter, produce or project advertised thereby, the sale of which is prohibited by any law, ordinance or statute.
- D. This section shall not apply to radios in homes or in private pleasure vehicles, when the same are operated in such manner as not to be audible at a distance of fifty feet (50') from such vehicle nor to noise devices, bands or other musical devices used in any public parade or procession which is operated under a permit in accordance with the ordinances of the village. (1966 Code § 569)

3-10-6: PENALTY:

Any person violating any provision of this chapter shall be fined as provided in section 1-4-1 of this code for each offense, and a separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day during or on which a violation occurs or continues. (1966 Code § 570; amd. 2013 Code)

Chapter 11 SPECIAL EVENT LICENSE ADMINISTRATIVE REGULATIONS

3-11-1: LICENSE REQUIRED; SUBJECTS OF LICENSING AUTHORITY:

No person shall conduct, maintain, operate, carry on or manage any special event, either individually or through an agent, employee, organization, or partner, for which a license is required by this chapter, without first having obtained a license for such special event.

A "special event" is defined as any activity in the village that is to be held, in any part, on property owned, and/or maintained by the village that requires any of the following:

- A. Additional police protection;
- B. Liquor license;
- C. Special assistance of village maintenance department;
- D. Installation of portable restrooms; and
- E. Additional insurance coverage by the village.

The village retains the sole discretion to determine whether an activity is considered a special event. Specifically, exempt activities include regular use of the village parks by organized youth sports leagues. (Ord. 2013-05, 3-13-2013, eff. 4-1-2013)
