

NOTICE OF HEARING BEFORE THE GOVERNMENT AFFAIRS COMMITTEE
OF THE VILLAGE OF NORTH UTICA

TO: Gary Denyes, d/b/a The CBD Joint

On June 11, 2021 at 2:00 P.M., the Government Affairs Committee (“GAC”) of the Village of North Utica (“Village”), will hold a hearing regarding the possible suspension and/or revocation of the Business License of the business known as “The CBD Joint”, located at 723 S. Clark Street, Utica, Illinois, Units 3 and 4, per the application of Gary Denyes. The Hearing will be held at Utica Village Hall, 801 S. Clark Street, Utica, Illinois.

The Hearing is being held pursuant to the Village of North Utica General Business License Provisions (Village Code Section 3-1-1 et.seq.). A copy of the ordinance is available at www.utica-il.gov or by contacting the Village Office at 815-667-4111. Pursuant to said ordinance, the business of The CBD Joint was ordered closed on May 28, 2021, pursuant to reports received from the Chief of Police, Rodney Damon. The operations of The CBD Joint is believed to constitute a nuisance, a clear and present danger to the public health, safety, or general welfare. The CBD Joint is believed to have been engaged in the sale of illegal drugs, including cannabis and/or products containing THC; and engaged in the sale of items to those under the age of twenty-one (21).

At said Hearing, you, Gary Denyes, shall be permitted the right to present evidence on your behalf, cross examine any witnesses, and be represented by counsel of your choosing. The Hearing may proceed whether or not you choose to attend.

The GAC may impose further suspension, revocation, and/or impose fines as provided by Village ordinance.
