## **General Requirements:**

- 1. Attach a drawing of the proposed sign to scale, indicating height, dimensions, wording, and elevation, and state specifically the type of sign, the location on the lot in relation to the building, and any landscaping of a freestanding sign base. The drawing should show the entire lot complete with setbacks to all property lines, existing building footprint, signs, north arrow, and scale.
- 2. A Village Floodplain Development Permit must be obtained if the property is in a floodplain.
- 3. No illuminated sign shall cause a traffic hazard for any passing motorists. The signs shall not interfere with a driver's ability to see approaching, merging, or intersecting traffic. All illuminated signs shall concentrate the illumination upon the area of the sign and shall minimize glare upon the street or adjacent property.
- 4. No freestanding sign shall be located closer than twenty-five (25) feet from any other sign located on another lot. No freestanding sign shall be located closer than one hundred fifty (150) feet from any other sign located on the same lot.
- 5. All signs in which electrical wiring and connections are required shall not endanger the health and safety of the public and shall be subject to the provisions of the National Electric Code.
- 6. All signs and the corresponding structural components shall not endanger the health and safety of the public.
- 7. Fire-resistant materials shall be used, and all letters and figures shall be securely attached to the sign structure.
- 8. The height of each sign shall conform to the regulations provided within each district in which the sign is located.
- 9. The owner of a sign, whether or not a permit is required, shall be required to maintain the sign in good structural and material condition, as determined by the Building Inspector. The sign and sign supports must be regularly painted to prevent rust and corrosion.
- 10. Please refer to the North Utica Zoning Ordinance (Chapter 16) for further regulations.
