It was motioned by Trustee Holland, seconded by Trustee Schweickert to approve the purchase of a Repeater Radio System for the North Utica Police Department at a cost not to exceed \$11,600.

Village Engineer: Engineer Heitz provided an update on the ongoing and upcoming projects in the Village.

Johnson St. Drainage – The area will need to be utility located and then the project will begin; tentatively on Monday, June 5, 2023.

2023 MFT Road Project – The Village went out for Bids on the 2023 MFT Road Project and there were two bids submitted. The Engineer's estimate for the project was \$336, 714.05.
