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#### **MINUTES**

At 6:04 pm the meeting was called to Order by Village President David Stewart who then led the Pledge of Allegiance. Village Clerk Laurie Gbur recorded the meeting attendance. Present at the meeting were Trustees, John Schweickert, Nate Holland, Kylie Mattioda, Debbie Krizel, Pete Pawlak and Jim Schrader. Also present were Village Attorney Herb Klein, Village Engineer Kevin Heitz, Public Works Director / Zoning Enforcement Officer Curt Spayer, Police Chief James Mandujano, Director of Village Affairs Jamie Turczyn and Village Treasurer Jill Margis.

Appearance Request: Viking Industrial Painting: Discussion regarding the Painting / Cleaning / Repairs & Maintenance of the North Utica Water Towers

Representatives of Viking Industrial presented information to the group regarding the current condition of the Village's Water Tower located on Norman Dr. that was built in 1991. During the initial inspection it was determined that the exterior of the Tower will require sand blasting, cleaning and painting due to the current wear of the paint. Once the exterior has been prepped and painted, there is also an upgraded coating that can be applied to extend the life of the exterior paint. This is an upgrade from the traditional polyurethane that is standard and this product has a 15 year warranty. They also provided information about the condition and repairs needed in the interior of the Water Tower as well as the estimated cost of the work. The Board thanked them for the information and will further discuss the options for the Water Tower at a future meeting.
